UPDATED LEARNING SETUP FOR SY2022-2023

As the world slowly opens and all signs point to the endemicity of COVID-19, the Dept. Of Education has released DepEd Order No. 34 s, 2022 stating the need to resume in-person classes or full implementation of face-to-face classes starting November 2. It is in this light that IMC is announcing some changes in our Learning Setup for SY2022-2023.

II. LEARNING SETUP

There will be two kinds of Learning Setup for students to choose:

- 1. Face-To-Face
- 2. Online up to October 31 only

As per the DepEd Order, starting November 2, no school is allowed to implement purely distance learning. As such, all students in the online learning setup are to be transitioned and integrated into the face-to-face classes.

Please note that online classes for the Grade School are during the PM time slot of 1:00-5:00PM. Therefore, if you are to return to in-person classes on November 2, then your default section will also be in the 1:00-5:00PM time slot.

IV. PLATFORMS USED, BOOKS & MATERIALS

Face-To-Face - All levels

- Daily face-to-face classes onsite in school for attendance and lessons
- Genyo E-Learning digital platform for books and lesson packages, created and uploaded by the teacher or preloaded content in Genyo. The Genyo Forum is a chat or two-way feature for communications between teacher and student, to ask questions and teacher can assist the student with the lesson at hand.

Online - All levels except for Grade 12

- Google Meet is where the students meet with teacher and classmates. This is where they have their Circle Time and have social interaction with classmates.
- Genyo E-Learning is where students are given lesson packages, whether created and uploaded by the teacher or preloaded content in Genyo. During Genyo time, both student and teacher will be online. The Genyo Forum is a two-way feature for discussions and recitations, where they can interact with each other, ask questions and teacher can assist the student with the lesson at hand.
- Online Consultation & Homeroom is where the class adviser meets the class via Google Meet, where everyone is visible to all participants and has real-time discussions. Checking of lesson understanding, completed book works, homework, etc. may be done also. Subjects such as CE and MAPEH/HELE are integrated at this time.

BOOKS AND MATERIALS

We cannot take away the tangible use of the books and materials in the development of writing skills and sensory growth, therefore, the purchase of books and materials for each grade level is still required.

It is also part of the online classes and homework to be done at home or during online homeroom sessions where checking of the books will be done by teacher through Google Meet. Other materials like notebooks, folders, spelling booklet, etc. are still essential materials needed by the student for note taking, math exercises or computations, compilation of guizzes and recording purposes.

V. LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (LMS) FOR ONLINE CLASSES

IMC will use both Genyo and Google Classroom as its Learning Management System (LMS). This digital platform is for submission of assignments, distribution of worksheets and learning materials, evaluation and storage of submitted works; while Google Classroom and its tools (Drive, Docs, Sheets, Calendar & Gmail) will be used for communication between parent & teacher, monitoring, consultations, and meetings with classmates and teacher.
